- 1. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984.
- 2. The Tameside Metropolitan Borough (Huddersfield Road, Stalybridge/Mossley) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 1993 is hereby revoked.

This Order will come into operation on 25th February 2011 and may be cited as
