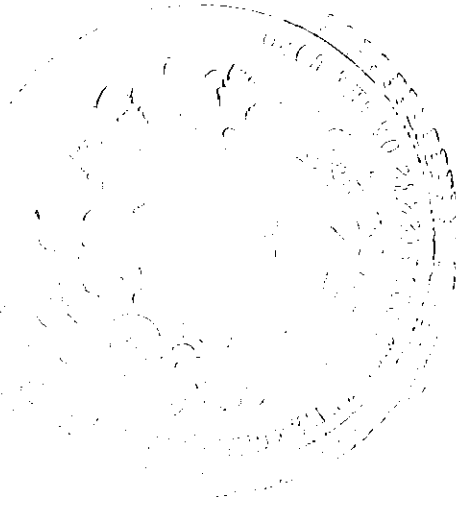

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF STALYBRIDGE (TRAFFIC REGULATION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1953

The Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Stalybridge in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (4) of section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order :-

1. The Borough Council of Stalybridge (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1950 shall have effect as though in Article 1 thereof for the words "Melbourne Street" there were substituted the following words

"in that length of Melbourne Street which lies between its junction with Grosvenor Street and the north end of the parapet walls of the bridge over the Huddersfield Canal".

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

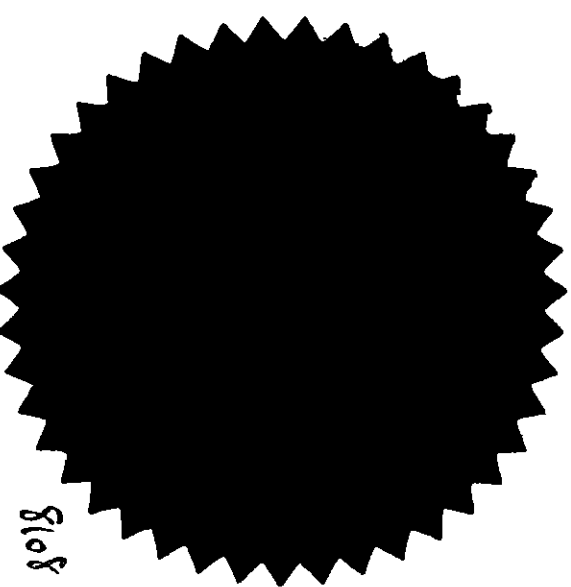
3. This Order may be cited as "The Borough Council of Stalybridge (Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) Order, 1953".
