

BOROUGH OF STALYBRIDGE

THE STALYBRIDGE (STAMFORD STREET AND RASSBOTTON STREET)(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1971

The Stalybridge Borough Council in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the sides of lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the sides of lengths of road referred to in that Article, for so long as may be necessary -
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said sides of lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
3. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the second day of August 1971, and may be cited as "The Stalybridge (Stamford Street and Rassbottom Street)(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971".

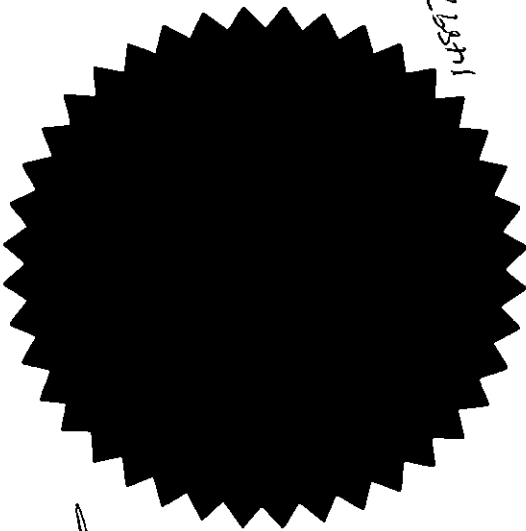

S C H E D U L E

Sides of lengths of road in the Borough of Stalybridge

1. Stamford Street - the north side, from its junction with Astley Road for a distance of 238 yards in an easterly direction.
2. Stamford Street/
Rassbottom Street - the south side, from the entrance to the Masonic Institute to the junction of Rassbottom Street and Stamford Drive.
3. Rassbottom Street - the north side, from its junction with Stamford Street for a distance of 90 yards in a south-easterly direction.
