

BOROUGH OF STALYBRIDGE

THE STALYBRIDGE
(NORMAN ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
ORDER 1969

The Council of the Borough of Stalybridge in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order :-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of road, known as Norman Road, in the Borough of Stalybridge, which extends from its junction with Stamford Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 33 yards.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of March, 1970 and may be cited as "The Stalybridge (Norman Road) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1969".
