THE STALYBRIDGE AND CHURCH	(MONTAGUE STREET, SPRING STREET, BLANDFORD STREET STREET) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER, 1971

The Council of the Borough of Stalybridge in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84 C (1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order.

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of June 1971 and may be cited as "The Stalybridge (Montague Street, Spring Street, Blandford Street and Church Street) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1971."

SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Borough of Stalybridge

1. That length of Montague Street which extends from its junction with Wakefield Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 16 yards.
2. That length of Spring Street which extends from its junction with Stamford Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 7 yards.
3. That length of Blandford Street which extends from its junction with Stamford Street in a north easterly direction for a distance of 22 yards.
4. That length of Church Street which extends from its junction with Wakefield Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 4 yards.
