

THE STALYBRIDGE (LONG ROW, CARRBROOK ROAD) (ONE-WAY) ORDER, 1965

The Stalybridge Borough Council in exercise of their powers under subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section 26 and subsection (4) of section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order :-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to that length in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle between the hours of 1.0 p.m. and 3.0 p.m.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty fourth day of March, 1965, and may be cited as "The Stalybridge (Long Row, Carrbrook Road) (One-Way) Order, 1965".

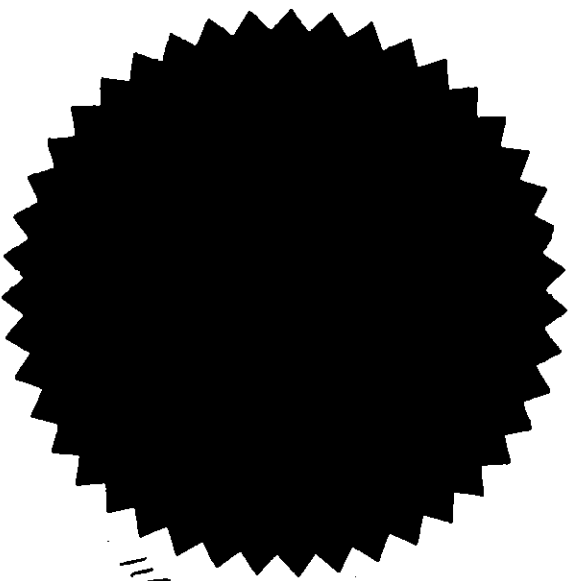
