## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1982

THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as "the said County Council") in exercise of the powers of the County Council under Section 1 (1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part 1X of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84 (c) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:—


- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Hough Hill Road, Stalybridge from its junction with Astley Street for a distance of 3 metres in a northerly direction.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 25th day of 1983 and may be cited as the "Greater Manchester County (Hough Hill Road, Stalybridge) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1982"
