

THE STALYBRIDGE (HIGH STREET) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER, 1970

The Stalybridge Borough Council in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order :-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road known as High Street in the Borough of Stalybridge, which extends from its junction with Caroline Street to its junction with the new road leading to Cheetham Park.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to in that Article, for so long as may be necessary :-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
 - (e) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of March, 1970, and may be cited as "The Stalybridge (High Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970".

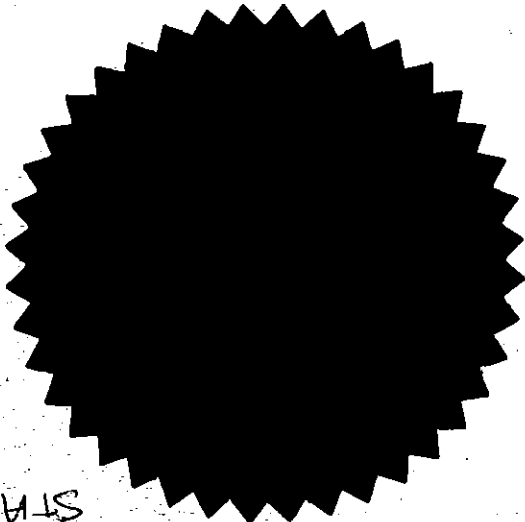
