

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1962

The Borough Council of Stalybridge (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1)
Order 1966

The Council of the Borough of Stalybridge in exercise of their powers under section 11(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1962, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County Palatine of Chester and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order as follows:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the nineteenth day of November, 1966 and may be cited as the Borough Council of Stalybridge (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order 1966.

That length of Wakefield Road (A.635), in the Borough of Stalybridge, which extends from a point 100 yards north of its junction with Spring Bank Lane to a point 50 yards north-east of the entrance to the Glent, an approximate distance of 1,780 yards.
