The Stalybridge (Restricted Roads)(No.1) Order 1971


The Stalybridge Borough Council in exercise of their powers under sections 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the county of Chester, hereby order and direct as follows -


1. The length of road in the Borough of Stalybridge known as High Street which extends from its junction with Caroline Street for a distance of approximately 615 yards to its junction with the new road leading to Cheetham Park shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. This Order may be cited as the Stalybridge (Restricted Roads) (No.1) Order 1971 and shall come into operation on the first day of October 1971.
