



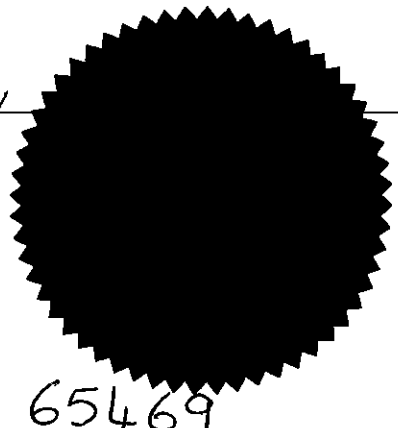
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(STAMFORD DRIVE, STALYBRIDGE)
(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Stamford Drive, Stalybridge, from a point 20 metres south west of Rassbottom Street to its junction with Rassbottom Street other than in that direction.
2. The Order shall come into operation on 17th November 1993 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (STAMFORD DRIVE, STALYBRIDGE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993".
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
