ORDER 1976

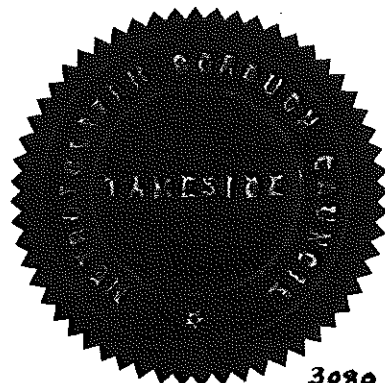
THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as "the said County Council") in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended in hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84c(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Stocks Lane Stalybridge in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside which extends from its junction with Mottram Road to its junction with Compton Street in a direction other than from West to East.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Compton Street Stalybridge in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside which extends from its junction with Stocks Lane to its junction with Mottram Road in a direction other than from North East to South West.
3. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter or leave Percy Street at its junction with Mottram Road Stalybridge in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside.
4. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter or leave Albion Street at its junction with Huddersfield Road Stalybridge in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside.
5. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
6. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty fourth day of August 1976, and may be cited as the Greater Manchester County (Mottram Road, Albion Street, Percy Street, Stocks Lane and Compton Street Stalybridge)(Prohibition of Driving and One-Way Traffic) Order 1976.
