(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) (BOROUGH) ORDER 1976

THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as "the said County Council") in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1(1)(2), (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transportation Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84(c) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:—


- 1. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Cumberland Street, Stalybridge, from its juntion with Ridgehill Lane, Stalybridge, to a point 6 metres north east of that junction.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of March 1977 and may be cited as the Greater Manchester County (Cumberland Street/Ridgehill Lane Junction, Stalybridge)(Prohibition of Driving)(Borough) Order 1976.
