(BUS STATION, STALYBRIDGE)
(PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 1999

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. In this Order:-

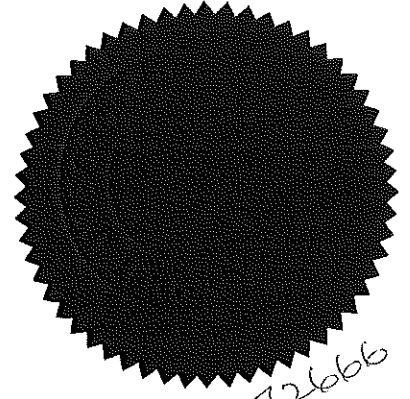
"bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter the bus station at its south easterly junction with Waterloo Road, (more clearly indicated on the attached plan).
3. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 to this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter the bus station at:-
 - (1) its north westerly junction with Waterloo Road, (more clearly indicated on the attached plan).
 - (2) its south westerly junction with Market Street and King Street, (more clearly indicated on the attached plan).
4. Nothing in Article 3 to this Order shall render it unlawful for any bus to enter the bus station from any of the junctions specified in that Article.
5. Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter the bus station specified in that Article so far as such entry is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for any of the following purposes:-
 - (1) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (2) police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (3) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties, the maintenance, cleansing, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (4) any building or demolition operations.

6. This Order will come into operation on 31st March 2000 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (BUS STATION, STALYBRIDGE) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 1999"

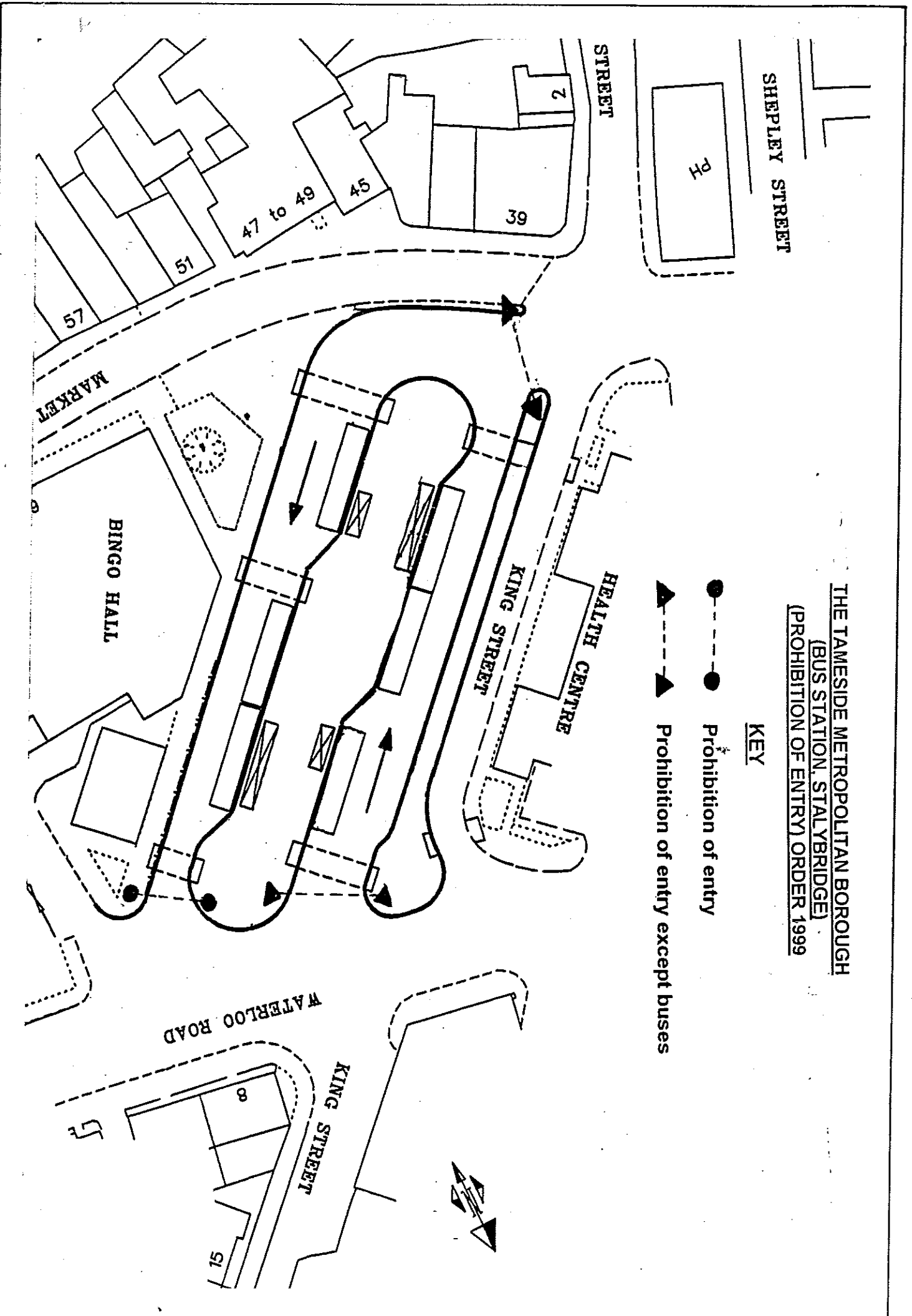


**THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
