
BOROUGH OF ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE.

(40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 1) ORDER 1963.

The Council of the Borough of Ashton-under-Lyne in exercise of their powers under section 11 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1962 after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Lancaster and with the consent of the Minister of Transport hereby order as follows :-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
3. This Order shall be cited as "The Borough of Ashton-under-Lyne (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order 1963"

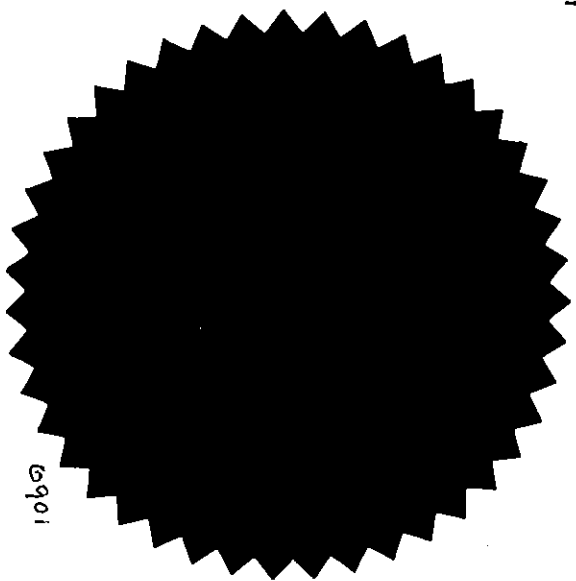
