THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (ARMENTIERES SQUARE AND TRINITY STREET, STALYBRIDGE) (RESTRICTION OF ACCESS AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) (AMENDMENT No.1) ORDER 1999

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (ARMENTIERES SQUARE AND TRINITY STREET, STALYBRIDGE) (RESTRICTION OF ACCESS AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 1997 shall be amended in so far as:-
 - (1) Article 2 to that Order was deleted therefrom and the following substituted therefore:-
 - 2. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order unless:-
 - (1) the vehicle is a bus;
 - (2) the vehicle is a hackney carriage using an authorised taxi rank between the hours of 7.00pm and 6.00am;
 - (3) the vehicle is loading or unloading to premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads or any premises accessible from and only from the said lengths of roads;
 - (4) the vehicle is loading or unloading to the Market Hall;
 - (5) the vehicle is accessing off-street garaging accessible from and only from the said lengths of roads.

(2) the Schedule to that Order was deleted therefrom and the following substituted therefore:-

SCHEDULE

(All vehicles prohibited except for buses, loading and unloading, taxis between 7pm and 6am and access to off street garaging)

Trinity Street

from a point 70 metres north west of its

junction with High Street to its junction with

Corporation Street.

Armentieres Square

from its southerly junction with Trinity Street around its southerly, westerly and northerly carriageways to its northerly

junction with Trinity Street.

2. This Order will come into operation on the 18th day of December 2000 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (ARMENTIERES SQUARE AND TRINITY STREET, STALYBRIDGE) (RESTRICTION OF ACCESS AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) (AMENDMENT No.1) ORDER 1999".
