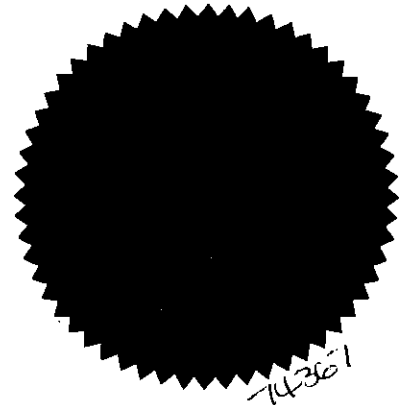
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(DEAN STREET, STALYBRIDGE)
(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2001

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
2. The TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (DEAN STREET, STALYBRIDGE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1997 is hereby revoked.
3. THE STALYBRIDGE (VARIOUS STREETS) ONE WAY AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1966 shall hereby have effect as though in the third Schedule to that Order all reference to Dean Street was deleted therefrom.

This Order will come into operation on the 29th day of November 2001 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (DEAN STREET, STALYBRIDGE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2001".
