THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. In this Order:
 - "bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002
- 2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any bus to enter or proceed in any of the lengths of roads in Stalybridge specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. This Order will come into operation on the 14th day of December 2006 and may be cited as

"THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (MARKET STREET, STALYBRIDGE) (PROHIBITION OF USE OF HIGHWAY BY BUSES) ORDER 2006".
