
(ST. CHRISTOPHERS ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1988

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH in exercise of its powers under Sections  $\overline{1(1)}$  and  $\overline{(2)}$ ,  $\overline{2(1)}$  to  $\overline{(3)}$  and  $\overline{4(2)}$  of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following order:-

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in St. Christophers Road, Ashton-under-Lyne from its junction with Lees New Road to its junction with Nook Lane other than in that direction.
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on ITH APRIL 1989 and may be cited as "The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (St. Christophers Road, Ashton-under-Lyne) (One Way Traffic) Order 1988".
