# TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (AUDENSHAW ROAD NEAR MANOR ROAD, AUDENSHAW) (BUS, PEDAL CYCLE AND TAXI LANE) (PEAK HOURS) ORDER 2014

and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act and all other enabling powers Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby makes the following Order:-

### (1) In this Order:-

"bus, pedal cycle and taxi lane" means any area of carriageway of a specified road, bounded on one side by either the kerb-line or the road marking complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs and General Directions 2002 and on the other side by the road marking complying with diagram 1049 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (or any amendment thereof).

"bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (or any amendment thereof):

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (or any amendment thereof):

"taxi" means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or under any similar enactment;

"specified road" means any road or length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order:
