TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009

The <u>Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council</u> (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 35 of the <u>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984</u> in relation to the provision of off-street parking in the metropolitan borough of Tameside and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the <u>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984</u>, hereby <u>makes the following Order: -</u>

RECITALS

- (A) Section 35A(1) of the <u>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984</u>, provides that in the event of any contravention of, or non-compliance with, a provision of an order made under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (provisions as to the use of parking places), the person responsible shall be guilty of an offence.
- (B) On 26 March 2007 the whole of the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside (except the lengths of the M60 and M67 within the Borough, including their on and off slip roads) was designated a permitted and special parking area under the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Tameside) Order 2007/547, which was made under Schedule 3 of the Road Traffic Act 1991.
- (C) On 31 March 2008, under section 74 and Schedule 8 of the <u>Traffic Management Act 2004</u>, the area was automatically re-designated as a civil enforcement area for parking contraventions.
- (D) Under section 73 and Schedule 7, part 1 paragraph 4(1) &(2)(d) of the <u>Traffic Management Act 2004</u>, there is a parking contravention in relation to a vehicle if it is stationary in a civil enforcement area in circumstances in which an offence under section 35A(1) would otherwise have been committed.
- (E) Under regulation 4 of the <u>Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England)</u>

 <u>General Regulations 2007</u>, where a parking contravention has been committed in relation to a vehicle, a penalty charge is payable.
- (F) Under Regulation 5 of the <u>Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England)</u>

 <u>General Regulations 2007</u>, the penalty charge shall be payable by the person who

was the Owner of the vehicle involved in the contravention at the material time (unless at the material time the Vehicle was hired from a vehicle hire firm and the requirements of regulation 5(3) are met).

- (G) Under schedule 8 of the <u>Traffic Management Act 2008</u>, the Council may make an application to designate its area as a civil enforcement area for the purposes of moving traffic contraventions.
- (H) Sections 101 to 103 of the <u>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984</u>, as amended, applies to the removal, storage and disposal of Vehicles under Part IV of this Order. Charges for the removal, storage and disposal of vehicles shall be set and published by the Council in accordance with Schedule 9 of the <u>Traffic Management</u> Act 2004

<u>PART I</u> GENERAL

1. This order shall come into operation on the 21st day of December 2009 and shall be cited as the <u>Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009.</u>

2. In this Order:

- ➤ "Apparatus" means an apparatus or device used in accordance with section 35(3) of the <u>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984</u> for the purposes detailed therein, including as a means to collect charges payable in respect of a vehicle in an off-street parking place;
- "Charging hours" means the period specified in the Column headed "Charging Hours" in Schedule 1 to this Order for which an advance charge in respect of parking a vehicle is payable;
- ➤ "Charge" means the charges detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order which are to be paid for a Vehicle waiting in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 5 & 6 of this Order;
- "Civic Parking Area" means an area within a Parking Place marked so as to indicate that it is reserved for use by vehicles displaying a Civic Parking Permit

- "Civic Parking Permit" means a badge or pass issued by the Council permitting the parking of a vehicle in such areas as are marked as a Civic Parking Bay during the period for which it is issued:
- "Disabled person's badge" means a badge issued and used in accordance with the <u>Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)</u> (England) Regulations 2000 as amended, or under any succeeding legislation, and shall include a badge issued under regulations having effect in Scotland or Wales under section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970:
- "Driver" shall have the meaning assigned to it by section 142(1) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- > "Fee" means the fees detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order which are to be paid for the purchase of Parking Permit, in accordance with paragraphs 8 & 10;
- "Motor Cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms, as defined in section 136 of the <u>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984</u>;
- "Motorcycle Areas" means an area within a Parking Place marked so as to indicate that it is designated for use by Motor Cycles;
- "Owner" means the person by whom the vehicle is kept; and for the purpose of determining who was the owner of the vehicle at any time, it shall be presumed that the owner was the person who was the registered keeper of the vehicle at that time;
- "park" means to stand or leave standing any Vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading of passengers or materials.
- "Parking Bay" means an area within a parking place indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place marked out for the leaving of a vehicle;
- > "Parking Permit" means such badge or pass issued by the Council which permits the parking of a Vehicle in such Parking Places as are specified thereon for the period for which the Parking Permit is

issued and for the time bands to which the charge paid relates as detailed in schedule 3 to this Order:

- "Parking Place" means any area of land or any building or part of a building specified in the column headed "location" in Schedule 1, and shown on the plans at Schedule 4, provided by the Council under section 32 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for use as an off street parking place;
- "Parking Ticket" means a ticket issued in accordance with clause 6 of this Order;
- "Permit Area" means an area within a Parking Place marked so as to indicate that it is reserved for use by vehicles displaying a Parking Permit;
- "Time Clock" means an approved device which conforms to BS 6571-7:1997 capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a Vehicle arrived at a parking place;
- > "Trailer" means a wheeled trailer which is towable behind a Vehicle;
- > "Trailer unit" means a trailer remaining attached to a vehicle whilst parked and any trailer shall be deemed to be a separate vehicle;
- > "Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads;

PART II

USE OF PARKING PLACE & CHARGES

- 3. This Order applies to the off street Parking Places named in Schedule 1 and shown by reference to a map in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- 4. Each Parking Place may be used by such classes of Vehicles, on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that Parking Place in Schedule 1, provided that the Council may individually authorise in writing any Vehicle to be left in any Parking Place without compliance with all or any of the provisions of this Order.
- 5. Where a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place during Charging Hours then a Charge shall be payable in accordance with the following provisions of this Order.
- 6. The driver of a vehicle shall immediately after leaving a Vehicle in a Parking Piace during Charging Hours pay the appropriate Charge as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order, by inserting a coin or coins of the appropriate value into the Apparatus provided, and complying with any instructions detailed upon or near that Apparatus, upon which a Parking Ticket will be issued for display in the Vehicle.
- 7. Any Parking Ticket issued as mentioned in clause 6 above shall be displayed in the Vehicle to which it relates in a conspicuous position so that the front of the Parking Ticket, including the date and time of issue, is clearly legible from the outside of the Vehicle.
- 8. On application to the Council and on receipt of payment in advance of the required fee as detailed in Schedule 3, the Council may issue a Parking Permit, which must be displayed in the Vehicle in a conspicuous position.
- 9. On application to the Council the Council may issue a Civic Parking Permit, which must be displayed in the Vehicle in a conspicuous position
- 10. Nothing in articles 5 or 6 or 31 shall require the driver to pay a Charge for a vehicle if the vehicle displays a valid Civic Permit or a Parking Permit in a conspicuous position

- 11. A Vehicle shall only be regarded as displaying a Parking Permit or Civic Parking Permit in a conspicuous position if the Parking Permit is exhibited on the front windscreen with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and in the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a windscreen the Parking Permit shall be exhibited on the front or nearside of the Vehicle's dashboard
- 12. Notwithstanding the provisions contained in this Order, a Charge shall not be payable in respect of a Motor Cycle provided that the Motor Cycle is parked within the markings of a Motor Cycle Area and in all other respects the use of the Motor Cycle complies with the provisions of this Order. A Motor Cycle parked in a Parking Bay which is not a Motorcycle Area will be subject to the charges set out in Schedule 2 to this Order as if it was a car.
- 13. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order the driver of a vehicle correctly displaying a disabled person's badge and Time Clock set to the time that vehicle has been left in the Parking Place may park their vehicle in any Parking Place listed in Schedule 1 to this Order for up to 3 hours without payment. Where more than 3 hours parking time is required, the appropriate charge as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order must be paid for the time in excess of three hours required, upon parking the vehicle.
- 14. When calculating charges to be paid for parking by vehicles complying with article 13 above, the tables set out in Schedule 2 to this Order will be used to calculate the charge but the length of stay purchased will be three hours longer than shown on the parking ticket.
- 15. Notwithstanding the provisions contained in this Order, a Charge shall not be payable if a Vehicle is parked in a Parking Place for the purpose of delivery of waste items or other materials to a recycling centre located in that Parking Place, provided that the Vehicle is not parked for more than 5 minutes and it is parked as close as is reasonably practicable to the recycling centre, without causing obstruction, and in all other respects the use of the Vehicle complies with the provisions of this Order.
- 16. The Council may at any time suspend the operation of any of the Parking Places in Schedule 1, and shown on the relevant maps in Schedule 4, at the discretion of the Council or by any person authorised by the Council. Notice of such

suspension shall be given by way of a notice or notices displayed at the Parking Place.

- 17. The Council may at any time reduce the number of available spaces at any of the Parking Places in Schedule 1 and shown on the relevant map in Schedule 4 as required and at the discretion of the Council or by any person authorised by the Council.
- 18. The Council may at any time temporarily waive or suspend the Charges for any Parking Place, at the discretion of the Council. Notice of such temporary waiver or suspension will be given by way of a notice or notices displayed at the Parking Place.
- 19. If at any time the Council shall require a Parking Place for any part thereof of any purpose whatsoever (including its use as a private car park in connection with a particular event) then the right of any person to park any Vehicle thereon shall immediately terminate until the Council shall no longer require the Parking Place or part thereof.
- 20. The driver of a vehicle with attached Trailer parked in any parking place listed in Schedule 1 to this Order in such a manner so that the vehicle and trailer unit occupy more than one parking bay must obtain two parking tickets and pay the appropriate fee for each ticket as listed in schedule 2 to this Order.

PART III

CONTRAVENTIONS

- 21. No person shall leave a Vehicle in a Parking Place in an area marked by the Council for loading, without reasonable excuse
- 22. No person shall use a Parking Place or part thereof in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of any article or goods to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services, except with the prior written permission of the Council.
- 23. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Permit Area during Charging Hours without conspicuously displaying a valid Parking Permit or Civic Parking Permit

- 24. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Civic Parking Area without conspicuously displaying a Civic Parking Permit
- 25. No person shall park a vehicle in a restricted area in a car park; such a restricted area may be marked by hatched lines, or double yellow lines, or otherwise indicated as not available for parking
- 26. Where a Parking Bay is designated and marked as available only for a disabled person's vehicle then no person shall park a Vehicle in that Parking Bay unless the Vehicle is clearly displaying a valid disabled persons badge and the Vehicle is being used in accordance with the <u>Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)</u> (England) Regulations 2000, as amended (or any subsequent or succeeding replacement legislation) and correctly set time clock in the relevant position and immediately before or immediately after the act of parking the vehicle has been or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the Disabled Persons Badge has been issued.
- 27. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place which exceeds the maximum weight for that Parking Place as specified in the column headed "Class of Vehicle" in Schedule 1 to this Order
- 28. Where a Parking Place or area in a Parking Place is marked so as to indicate that it is designated for use by a specified class of Vehicle, then no person shall park a Vehicle in that area other than a Vehicle of the specified class.
- 29. No person shall park a Vehicle in such a manner that it obstructs any other Vehicle or any part of the Parking Place or otherwise causes an obstruction,
- 30. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place during Charging Hours without paying the Charge applicable for that Parking Place,
- 31. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place for longer than the Maximum Waiting Period for that Parking Place detailed in Schedule 1 except where a disabled person's badge and correctly set Time Clock are displayed and the appropriate fee paid.
- 32. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours after the expiry of the time period for which payment has been made. In the case of a

vehicle displaying a Disabled person's badge and correctly set Time Clock the time period shall be deemed to be

- A) the expiry time displayed on the ticket plus 3 hours if a ticket is displayed); or
- ❖ B) three hours from when the Vehicle was left in the Parking Place (if no ticket is displayed)
- 33. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours if the Vehicle displays a Parking Ticket previously displayed on another Vehicle.
- 34. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place if the Vehicle displays a Parking Ticket which was purchased in another car park, unless that Parking Ticket was purchased after 6pm on the date of display, or the ticket was purchased in the Camp Street Parking Place and is displayed on a Vehicle in the Sackville Street Parking Place
- 35. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place if the Vehicle displays a Parking Ticket or Parking Permit which has been altered, defaced, mutilated, added to, upon which the figures or particulars have become illegible or which is otherwise invalid.
- 36. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place if the Vehicle displays a Parking Ticket which details a registration number which does not match the registration number of the Vehicle in which it is displayed
- 37. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours without displaying a valid Parking Ticket, Parking Permit, Civic Parking Permit or Disabled Person's Badge with correctly set Time Clock.
- 38. No person shall re-park a Vehicle in a Parking Place within one hour of leaving a space or Parking Bay within that Parking Place
- 39. Where a Parking Place is marked with Parking Bays, Vehicles must be parked wholly within the marked Parking Bays and no person shall park a Vehicle beyond or across the bay markings.
- 40. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place when signs at that Parking Place state that it is closed

- 41. When the operation of a parking place is suspended pursuant to paragraph 16 of this Order, no person shall cause any Vehicle to enter, stand, wait or be left in the Parking Place or any part thereof for the duration of the suspension, except for a Vehicle authorised by or on behalf of the Council.
- 42. Except with the written permission of the Council, no person shall use a Parking Place or Parking Bay or part thereof: -
 - > For the purposes of sleeping, camping or cooking
 - ➤ For the purpose of servicing or washing any Vehicle or part thereof other than is absolutely necessary to enable the Vehicle to safely depart from the Parking Place.
 - > For the erection or pitching of any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure.
 - > For the parking of an exhibition trailer or caravan.
 - > For the lighting of any fire.
 - > For any indecent, Improper offensive or obscene behaviour which may cause harassment alarm or distress
- 43. No person shall use a Parking Place for the purpose of displaying or distributing advertising material, unless with the prior written consent of the Council.
- 44. Pursuant to section 35A(5) of the Road Traffic Act Regulation 1984, whilst a Vehicle is within a Parking Place, it shall not be lawful for the driver, or any person employed in connection with it, to ply for hire or accept passengers for hire.
- 45. No person shall park or leave a Vehicle to wait in a Parking Place unless the Vehicle is licensed as required by and in accordance with the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994
- 46. No person shall use a Parking Place as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another road.
- 47. No person shall sound a Vehicle's horn or other similar instrument in a Parking Place except when necessary to safely change position of the Vehicle or to safely depart from the Parking Bay or the Parking Pace.
- 48. Where in a Parking Place there are signs erected or surface markings indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place, then no person shall drive a Vehicle

- so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by the indicated entrance or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an indicated exit.
- 49. Where in a Parking Place there are signs erected or surface markings indicating that Vehicles should proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place then no person shall drive a Vehicle in a direction otherwise than as so marked or indicated.
- 50. No person shall drive a Vehicle in a Parking Place other than for the purpose of leaving that Vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place.
- 51. A person shall not in the Parking Place wilfully, carelessly or negligently deface, damage or destroy any part of the Parking Place or any wall, fence or barrier, or any fitting or equipment in or on the parking place.
- 52. The British Rail Parking Place, as identified in Schedules 1 and 4, shall only be available as a Parking Place under the provisions of this order on week days (being Monday to Friday).
- 53. For the avoidance of doubt and pursuant to section 35A(3)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Person Responsible for any contravention or non compliance with this Order shall be person who was the Owner of the vehicle involved in the contravention at the material time

PART IV

REMOVAL, STORAGE AND DISPOSAL OF A VEHICLE

- 54. If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of this Order the Council, or any person authorised by the Council, may alter or cause to be altered the position of the Vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions.
- 55. If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order then the Council, or any person authorised by the Council, may remove the Vehicle from that parking place or arrange for such removal.
- 56. For the purposes of meeting the requirements of an emergency, the Council, a person authorised by the Council, or a police officer in uniform may alter or cause

to be altered the position of a Vehicle in the Parking Place or arrange for the removal of a Vehicle from a Parking Place.

- 57. Any Vehicle which appears to the Council to be abandoned in a Parking Place may be removed at the discretion of the Council, or a person authorised by the Council, or at the request of a police officer in uniform.
- 58. Any Vehicle subject to the provisions of paragraphs 54 to 57 may be towed, driven or moved in such other manner necessary to enable the position of the Vehicle to be altered or the Vehicle to be removed.
- 59. For the purposes of this Order, section 101 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, has effect and the Council may dispose of a Vehicle which appears to it to be abandoned and which has been, or could at any time be, removed in pursuance of this Order, in accordance with the provisions of section 101.
- 60. Section 102 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, together with subordinate legislation, shall apply in respect of the recovery by the Council of charges for the removal, storage and disposal of Vehicles under the provisions of this Order.

PART V

REVOCATION

61. The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2005, the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council Greenside Lane Droylsden (Off Street-Parking Places) Order 2005, and the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Minor Variation No.1) Order 2007 are hereby revoked.

TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2012

The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as the "Council") in exercise of its powers under section 35 of the of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order is supplemental to the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (as amended) ("the 2009 Order") which subject to the amendments hereinafter mentioned remains in full force and effect.
- 2. This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of January 2012 and may be cited as the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) (No 1) Order 2012.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- The 2009 Order shall be amended as set out in the following provisions of this Order.
- 5. (1) The words "Parking Permit" shall be replaced with "Contract Pass" wherever they appear in the 2009 Order.
 - (2) A new defined term "Permit Parking Place" shall be inserted in Article 2 of the 2009 Order before the definition of "Parking Place":-
 - "Permit Parking Place" means any area of land or any building or part of a building specified in Schedule 3 provided by the Council under s32 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for use as an off street parking place only for Vehicles displaying a Contract Pass,
 - (3) The defined term "Time Clock" which appears at Article 2 of the 2009 Order shall be deleted.
- 6. Amend article 11 to the 2009 Order to read:-
 - "11. A Vehicle shall only be regarded as displaying a Contract Pass or Civic Permit in a conspicuous position if the Contract Pass or Civic Permit is exhibited on the front windscreen with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and in the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a windscreen the Contract Pass or Civic Permit shall be exhibited on the front or nearside of the Vehicle's dashboard"
- 7. Amend article 12 to the 2009 Order to read:-
 - *12. For the purposes of article 6, the appropriate Charge for the parking of a Motor Cycle shall be that specified for Motor Cycles if the Motor Cycle is parked within the markings of a Motor Cycle Area and in all other respects complies with the provisions of this Order. A Motor Cycle parked in a Parking

Place which is not a Motor Cycle Area will be subject to the charges set out in Schedule 2 to this Order as if it was a car.

- 8. Amend article 13 to the 2009 Order to read:-
 - "13. The driver of a Vehicle correctly displaying a disabled person's badge may park their vehicle in any Parking Place listed in Schedule 1 to this Order and shall, upon purchase of a ticket, be entitled to park in the Parking Place for an hour longer than the time paid for".
- 9. Amend article 14 to the 2009 Order to read:-
 - "14. When calculating charges to be paid by vehicles complying with article 13 above the tables set out in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be used to calculate the charge but the length of stay will be one hour longer than shown on the Parking Ticket".
- 10. Amend article 26 to the 2009 Order read :-
 - "26. Where a Parking Bay is designated and marked as available only for a disabled person's vehicle then no person shall park a Vehicle in that Parking Place unless the Vehicle is clearly displaying a valid Disabled person's badge and the Vehicle is being used in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended (or any subsequent or succeeding legislation)".
- 11. Amend article 31 to the 2009 Order to read:-
 - "31. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place for longer than the maximum waiting period for that Parking Place detailed in Schedule 1 except that where a disabled person's badge is displayed in the Vehicle and the appropriate charge has been paid and the Vehicle is being used in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended (or any subsequent or succeeding legislation).
- 12. Amend article 32 to the 2009 Order to read :-
 - "32. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours after the expiry of the time period for which payment has been made. In the case of a vehicle displaying a Disabled person's badge where the Vehicle is being used in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended (or any subsequent or succeeding legislation) the time period shall be sixty minutes later than the expiry time displayed on the ticket".
- 13. Amend article 37 to the 2009 Order to read:-
 - "37. No person shall park a Vehicle in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours without displaying a valid Parking Ticket or Contract Pass".
- 14(1) Insert a new row in Schedule 1 to the 2009 Order after the heading "Ashton under Lyne Outer Zone" as follows:
