TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (REYNER STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1989

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following order:-

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Reyner Street from its junction with Stamford Square to a point 92 metres south of that junction other than in a southerly direction.
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on 19.2.90, and may be cited as "The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Reyner Street) (One Way Traffic) Order 1989".
