THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE BUS STATION) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACE) REGULATIONS 1985

Whereas in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 38 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Greater Manchester County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") have provided the parking place described in the Schedule hereto.

Now, therefore, the Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Regulations.

- 1. It is hereby declared that sub-section (7) of Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which prohibits persons employed in connection with vehicles within a parking place plying for hire or accepting passengers for hire) shall not apply to public service vehicles when using the said parking place off Warrington Street.
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as the Greater Manchester County (Ashton-under-Lyne Bus Station) (Off-Street Parking Place) Regulations 1985.

The plot of land situated off Warrington Street, Ashton-under-Lyne in the Borough of Tameside in the County of Greater Manchester containing in the whole 8650 square metres or thereabouts and more particularly delineated on the map annexed to the Greater Manchester County (Ashton-under-Lyne Bus Station) (County) Order 1985 and thereon edged red.
