(RESTRICTION OF ACCESS AND TRAFFIC REGULATION)
(AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 1995

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1 THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (GAS STREET AND COTTON STREET EAST, ASHTON-U-LYNE)(RESTRICTION OF ACCESS AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 1993 is hereby amended in so far as :-

- (i) In Article 1(1) to that Order the following paragraph shall be incorporated :-

"authorised taxi rank" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994:-

"taxi" has the same meaning as in Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or any similar enactment:-


- (ii) in Article 9 to that Order the following shall be inserted :-

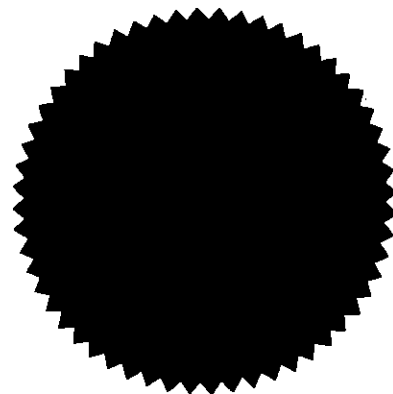
(6) Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being a taxi to wait upon an authorised taxi rank.

2. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

The Order shall come into operation on the 7th of July 1995 and may be cited as
