THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (WILLIAMSON STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Williamson Street, Ashton-under-Lyne from its junction with Gas Street to a point 23 metres east of its junction with Oldham Road in a direction other than from east to west.
- 2. THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (CAVENDISH STREET / OLDHAM ROAD AREA, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (COUNTY) ORDER 1982 shall have effect as though in Schedule 1 to that Order the following length of road and direction relating thereto was deleted therefrom:

Williamson Street from the junction with Gas Street to the junction with Oldham Road.

- 3. Nothing in Article 1 to this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
- 4. The Order shall come into operation on 4th Mach 1993 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (WILLIAMSON STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993".
