
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(WILLIAMSON STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)
(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

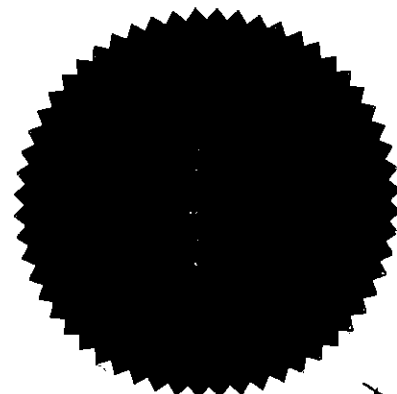
1. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Williamson Street, Ashton-under-Lyne from its junction with Gas Street to a point 23 metres east of its junction with Oldham Road in a direction other than from east to west.
2. THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (CAVENDISH STREET / OLDHAM ROAD AREA, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (COUNTY) ORDER 1982 shall have effect as though in Schedule 1 to that Order the following length of road and direction relating thereto was deleted therefrom:

Williamson Street from the junction with Gas Street to the junction with Oldham Road.
3. Nothing in Article 1 to this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
4. The Order shall come into operation on 4th March 1993 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (WILLIAMSON STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993".
