THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as "the said Council") in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. The Borough of Ashton-under-Lyne (Stamford Square) (One Way Traffic) Order 1973 is hereby revoked.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation of 15th day of July 1984 and may be cited as the Greater Manchester County (Corkland Street/Hall Street/Stamford Square/Audley Street, Ashton-under-Lyne) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1984.
