THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (SNIPE WAY, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC AND PRESCRIBED ROUTE) ORDER 1995

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1,2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the westerly leg of Snipe Way from a point 40 metres south of Manchester Road to its junction with Manchester Road other than in that direction.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
- Every person causing any vehicle to proceed in the westerly leg of Snipe Way shall cause that vehicle, upon reaching the junction with Manchester Road, to make a left turn into Manchester Road.
- 4. The Order shall come into operation on Thursday 11th January 1995 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (SNIPE WAY, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE WAY AND PRESCRIBED ROUTE) ORDER 1995"
