THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (LADBROOKE ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall, except upon the
 direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic
 warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that length of Ladbrooke
 Road from its junction with Broadoak Road to its junction with Smallshaw
 Lane other than in that direction.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
- The Order shall come into operation on 18th June 1995 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (LADBROOKE ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995".
