THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (WELLINGTON ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (LOADING ONLY) ORDER 2000

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. (1) Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or the land adjacent to, the sides of lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
 - (e) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or

- (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 1 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, at any time.
- 4. THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (WELLINGTON ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1994 shall have effect as though in Schedule 1 to that Order the length of road specified in Part 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order was deleted therefrom and the lengths of road specified in Part2 of Schedule 2 to this Order substituted therefore.
- 5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

The Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of July 2000 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (WELLINGTON ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (LOADING ONLY) ORDER 2000".

SCHEDULE 1

(Loading only)

Wellington Road (south west side)

from its junction with the Town Hall service road east of the Town Hall for a distance of 19 metres in a north westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

PART 1 (Deletion)

Wellington Road (southerly side)

from its junction with Market Street for a distance of 120 metres in a north westerly direction.

PART 2 (Substitution)

Wellington Road (southerly side)

from its junction with Market Street to its junction with the Town Hall service road east of the Town Hall.

from a point 19 metres north west of the Town Hall service road east of the Town Hall to a point 120 metres north west of its junction with Market Street.
