THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY
(URBAN CORE) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING OF
GOODS VEHICLES AND BUSES) (COUNTY) ORDER 1983

The Greater Manchester County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

1.(1) In this Order:-

"goods vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 196 (1) of the Road Traffic Act 1972;

"large passenger carrying vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than 12 seated passengers in addition to the driver and which is not a public service vehicle;

"designated street" means any road or part of a road which is for the time being authorised to be used as a parking place for goods vehicles and large passenger carrying vehicles in terms of an Order made by the Greater Manchester County Council under Section 28 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended;

"urban core" means any road or any length of road within the area of the County of Greater Manchester which is shown on the plan attached to this Order, the entry points to the aforesaid area being those specified in the Schedule to this Order;

"maximum gross weight" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 1981 (as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) Regulations 1982).

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any goods vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 3.5 tonnes or any large passenger carrying vehicle to wait between the hours of 7 pm one day and 7 am on the day next following, or between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm on a Sunday in the urban core other than in a designated street.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply:-
 - (a) so as to prevent a vehicle waiting in any road other than a designated street for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such

purpose without waiting in that street, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction or potential obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road or the erection, laying, placing, maintenance, testing, alteration, repair or removal of any structure, works or apparatus in, on, under or over the road or premises adjoining the road;

- (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (c) to a vehicle waiting in a road other than a designated street while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is opened or closed;
- (d) to a vehicle waiting in a road other than a designated street for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle provided that such loading or unloading can be reasonably carried out only from the road and that it takes place only whilst no prohibition of loading and unloading in the road by virtue of any other Order is in force:
- (e) to a vehicle in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (f) so as to prevent a vehicle waiting in a road other than a designated street for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (g) in connection with a circus, fair or similar event, the holding of which within the area shown on the plan attached to this Order has been authorised by the Greater Manchester County Council or by the Manchester City Council or by the Oldham Borough Council or by the Salford City Council or by the Stockport Borough Council or by the Tameside Borough Council or by the Trafford Borough Council or by the Bury Borough Council;
- (h) so as to prevent a vehicle waiting in a road other than a designated street for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any road;
- (i) so as to prevent a vehicle waiting in a road other than a designated street for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.
- 4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1967 or by or under any other enactment.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the 14th May 1984 and may be cited as the Greater Manchester County (Urban Core) (Restriction of Waiting of Goods Vehicles and Buses) (County) Order 1983.
