## THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (TOWN HALL SERVICE ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (RESTRICTION OF ACCESS)(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2003

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

## 1. In this Order: -

"Permit," means a permit issued by the council authorising the driver of the vehicle to leave their vehicle in the parking bays in either of the following areas of land:-

- a) The area of land bounded by the Town Hall Service Road and Wellington Road.
- b) The area of land bounded by the Town Hall Service Road, the east side of Ashton Town Hall, the Market Ground and the north side of the Market Hall.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order hereto unless that vehicle is displaying in the relevant position a valid permit issued by the Council.
- 3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in that Article so far as such entry or proceeding is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for any of the purposes specified in paragraph (2) of this Article.
  - (2) The purposes referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article are:
    - a) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads;
    - d) in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
    - e) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or the land adjacent to, the sides of lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.


- f) the vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- g) Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.

The Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of August 2003 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (TOWN HALL SERVICE ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)(RESTRICTION OF ACCESS)(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2003".
