THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (SERVICE AREAS, GAS STREET/KATHERINE STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (EXPERIMENTAL) (EXTENSION NO. 1) (COUNTY) ORDER 1980

The Greater Manchester County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- The Greater Manchester County (Service Areas, Gas Street/Katherine Street, Ashton-under-Lyne) (Restriction of Waiting) (Experimental) (County) Order 1979 shall continue in force until the 27th May 1981.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 27th November, 1980 and may be cited as The Greater Manchester County (Service Areas, Gas Street/Katherine Street, Ashton-under-Lyne) (Restriction of Waiting) (Experimental) (Extension No. 1) (County) Order 1980
