



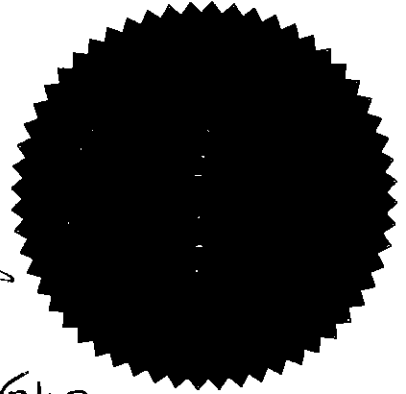
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(WELLINGTON ROAD, MARKET STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)
(PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND TURN) ORDER 1992

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in Wellington Road, Ashton-under-Lyne in the Tameside Metropolitan Borough to make a right-hand turn into Market Street.
2. The Interpretation Act 1987 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 14th December 1992 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (WELLINGTON ROAD, MARKET STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND TURN) ORDER 1992".
