



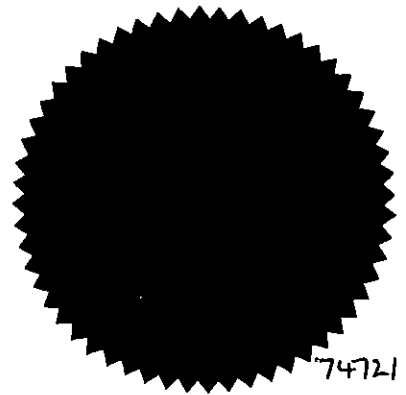
**THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(LEES ROAD (B6194), ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2002**

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Any existing Orders, by virtue of which the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order became a de-restricted road, are hereby revoked.
3. This Order will come into operation on 8th April 2002 and may be cited as **"THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (LEES ROAD (B6194))(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2002"**.
