THE TAMESIDE METROPOITAN BOROUGH (QUEEN STREET RAILWAY BRIDGE, ASTON-UNDER-LYNE) (TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2003

WHEREAS the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), the Highway Authority for Queen Street, Ashton-under-Lyne in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside, are satisfied that traffic should be restricted as referred to hereunder.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers contained in section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle which exceeds a maximum of 17 tonnes gross weight to proceed in the length of the road as is carried by the Queen Street railway bridge (MVL1/30), Ashton-under-Lyne, over the Stalybridge to Ashton-under-Lyne railway line.
- This Order will come into operation on the 13th October 2003 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (QUEEN STREET RAILWAY BRIDGE, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)
 (TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2003".


