## THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (OLD STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2005

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in Column 2 of that Schedule.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any vehicle being used for Ambulance, Fire Brigade or Police purposes if the observance of any provision of this Order would hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose on which it is being used on that occasion.
- 3. This Order will come into operation on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June 2005 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (OLD STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2005".
