THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH  
(OLD CROSS STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)  
(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2012

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 to this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any vehicle being used for Ambulance, Fire Brigade or Police purposes if the observance of any provision of this Order would hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose on which it is being used on that occasion.
4. THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (OLD CROSS STREET, GLEBE STREET, MULBERRY STREET, SWAN STREET, FLETCHER STREET, CORK STREET, GEORGE STREET AND WELLINGTON ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING, ONE WAY TRAFFIC, TAXI RANK AND LOADING BAY) ORDER 2007 shall have the effect as though in Schedule 3 to that Order the length of road 'Old Cross Street' were deleted therefrom.
5. THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL CAMP STREET, HENRIETTA STREET, ASHTON UNDER LYNE PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND ONE-WAY ORDER 1992 is hereby revoked.
6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

This Order will come into operation on 21<sup>st</sup> day of September 2012 and may be cited as (OLD CROSS STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2012
