(WINDERMERE AVENUE, DENTON)

(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) (BOROUGH) ORDER 1977

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as the "said County Council") in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84c(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Windermere Avenue, Denton, other than in a south-easterly direction from Windmill Lane to a point 10 metres north west of Rydal Close, Denton.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Order shall come into operation on 16th day of May 1977 and may be cited as THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (WINDERMERE AVENUE, DENTON)(ONE WAY TRAFFIC)(BOROUGH) ORDER 1977.

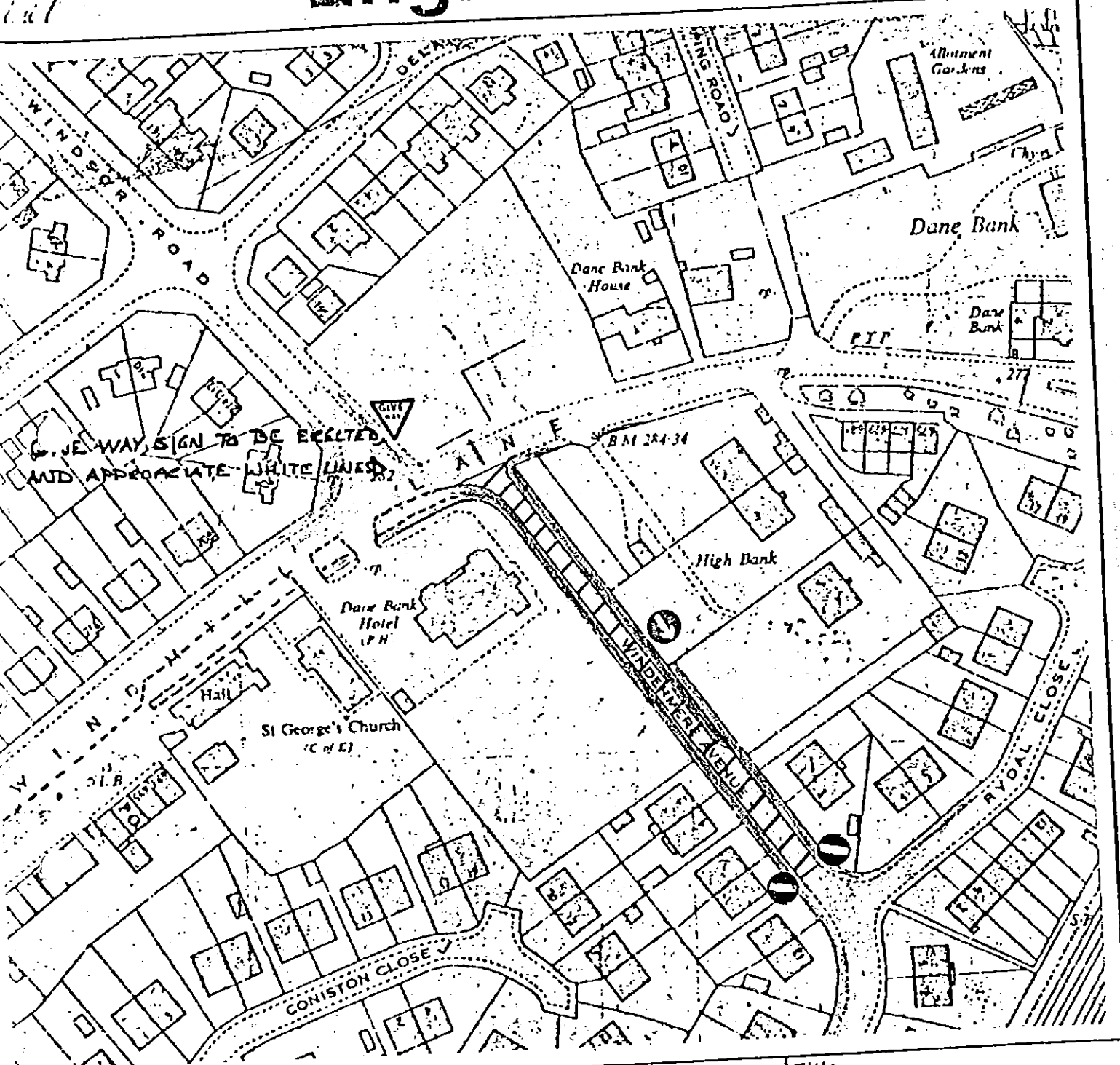
