THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (RUSSELL SCOTT FOOTBRIDGE AND ANGEL STREET FOOTBRIDGE, DENTON) (PROHIBITION OF CYCLING) (COUNTY) ORDER 1980

The Greater Manchester County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall ride or cause to be ridden any pedal bicycle or tricycle on the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd November 1980 and may be cited as The Greater Manchester County (Russell Scott Footbridge and Angel Street Footbridge, Denton) (Prohibition of Cycling) (County) Order 1980
