That length of Manchester Road South (A57) which extends from the westerly kerbline of Seymour Street to the westerly kerbline of Oldham Street, a distance of approximately 447 metres.

That length of Oldham Street which extends from Manchester Road North to Manchester Road South, a distance of approximately 46 metres.
