The A57 Manchester — Hyde — Mottram Trunk Road (Denton)
(Detrunking) Order 1982.

Made - - - - -	7th June	1982
Coming into Operation	1st August	1982

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The lengths of the Trunk Road described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be trunk road and shall be classified as principal road as from the date on which this Order comes into operation.

2. In this Order:—

(i) "the deposited plan" means the plan numbered NWRT 5035/80/17 marked "The A57 Manchester—Hyde—Mottram Trunk Road (Denton) (Detrunking) Order 1982" signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, 43 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;

(ii) "principal road" as a classification for a highway means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State; and

(iii) "the Trunk Road" means the A57 Manchester—Hyde—Mottram Trunk Road.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 1st August 1982 and may be cited as the A57 Manchester—Hyde—Mottram Trunk Road (Denton) (Detrunking) Order 1982.

SCHEDULE

LENGTHS OF ROAD CEASING TO BE TRUNK ROAD

small caps

1. That length of the Trunk Road known as Manchester Road which extends from a point 224 metres (246 yards) west of its junction with Oldham Street Denton in an easterly direction for a distance of 400 metres (437 yards).
2. That length of the Trunk Road known as the Heaton Street extension which extends from a point 224 metres (246 yards) west of its junction with Oldham Street Denton in an easterly direction for a distance of 224 metres (246 yards).
3. That length of the Trunk Road which extends from its junction with Seymour Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 1360 metres (1487 yards) to its junction with St Annes Road.
