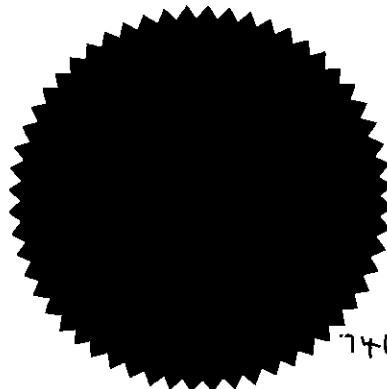
**(HAUGHTON HALL ROAD AREA, DENTON)(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT)  
ORDER 2001**

The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-


1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Haughton Hall Road Area, Denton)(20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2001, and shall come into force on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2002.
