## ROAD TRAFFIC

THE TRUNK ROADS (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NO.14 ) ORDER 1971

MADE

12TH MAY 1971

COMING INTO OPERATION OTH JUNE 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, (b) and of all other enabling powers, hereby orders as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Roads (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 14 ) Order 1971 and shall come into operation on the 9TH JUNE 1971.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889 (c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule to this Order.

## SCHEDULE

That length of the Manchester-Hyde-Mottram Trunk Road (A57), known locally as Manchester Road, in the Urban District of Denton, in the County Palatine of Lancaster, which extends from its junction with Wilton Grove in an easterly direction to its junction with Jackson Street, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 847 yards.
