The Urban District Council of Denton (Various Foot-paths) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order, 1960.

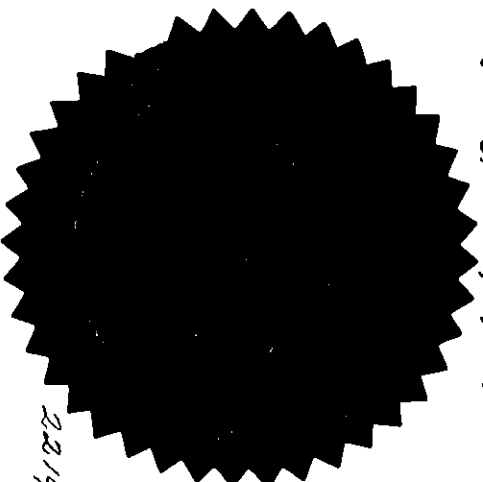
THE DENTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order :-

1. No person shall ride or cause or permit to be ridden any bicycle or tricycle on any of the lengths of footpath specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the First day of April, 1961, and may be cited as "The Urban District Council of Denton (Various Footpaths) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order, 1960".

SCHEDULE.

- (a) The whole length of the footpath leading from Windsor Road to Radnor Avenue.
- (b) The whole length of the footpath leading from Thompson Road to Manchester Road.
- (c) The whole length of the footpath leading from Mansfield Avenue to Leaford Avenue.
- (d) The whole length of the footpath leading from Leaford Avenue to Derby Road.
- (e) The whole lengths of the footpaths leading from Foxhall Road to Mansfield Avenue.
- (f) The whole length of the footpath leading from Ruby Street to Lees Avenue.
- (g) The whole length of the footpath leading from Victoria Street to Willow Grove.
- (h) The whole length of the footpath leading from the rear of No. 25 Town Lane to Stockport Road via Colliery Fields.
- (j) The whole length of the footpath leading from the junction of Town Lane with The Avenue to Regent Drive then from Regent Drive to Kingsley Close then from Kingsley Close to a point 135 yards south east of the disused mineral railway.
- (k) The whole length of the footpath leading from Tomcroft to the

junction of The Avenue with Town Lane.

- (1) Walton Way leading from Worthington Road to Flemish Road.
- (m) That part of Danwood Close serving the properties Nos. 15 to 33 and 2 to 12 Danwood Close.
- (n) The whole length of the footpath south of Moorfield Avenue leading from a point at the side of No. 22 Moorfield Avenue to a point at the side of No. 124 Moorfield Avenue.
