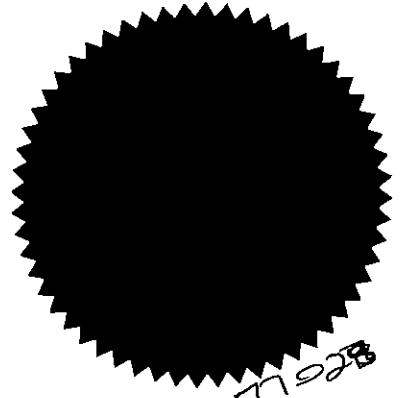
**TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL
(CLARE STREET AND PALATINE STREET, DENTON) (20 MPH SPEED
LIMIT) ORDER 2003**


The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Wilton Street, Milton Street, Palatine Street and Clare Street, Denton)(20mph Speed Limit) Order 2001 is hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Clare Street and Palatine Street, Denton)(20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2003, and shall come into force on 30th September 2004.


