The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under section 84(1)(a), (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. THE TRUNK ROADS (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)(NO.8) ORDER 1982 is hereby revoked
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

The Order shall come in to operation on the 1st November 2013 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (MANCHESTER ROAD NORTH, MANCHESTER ROAD SOUTH (A57), DENTON) (40 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2013

MANCHESTER ROAD NORTH

from a point 58 metres east of its junction with Stanley Road to a point 100 metres east of its junction with Derby Street

from the boundary of M60/M67 roundabout to a point 58 metres east of its junction with Stanley Road

from its junction with Oldham Street to a point 49 metres west of its junction with Alphagate Drive

LINK ROAD (near the dual carriageway opposite Jackson Street)

from its junction with Manchester Road South to its junction with Manchester Road North
