

THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY
(HALCROW STREET, DROYLSDEN) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
(COUNTY) ORDER 1983

The Greater Manchester County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 11th May, 1984 and may be cited as The Greater Manchester County (Halcrow Street, Droylsden) (Prohibition of Driving) (County) Order 1983.

Road in the Borough of Tameside

Halcrow Street, Droylsden

being the unsigned street on the southerly gable of the Beehive Public House from the western kerbline of Market Street for 2 metres in a westerly direction.

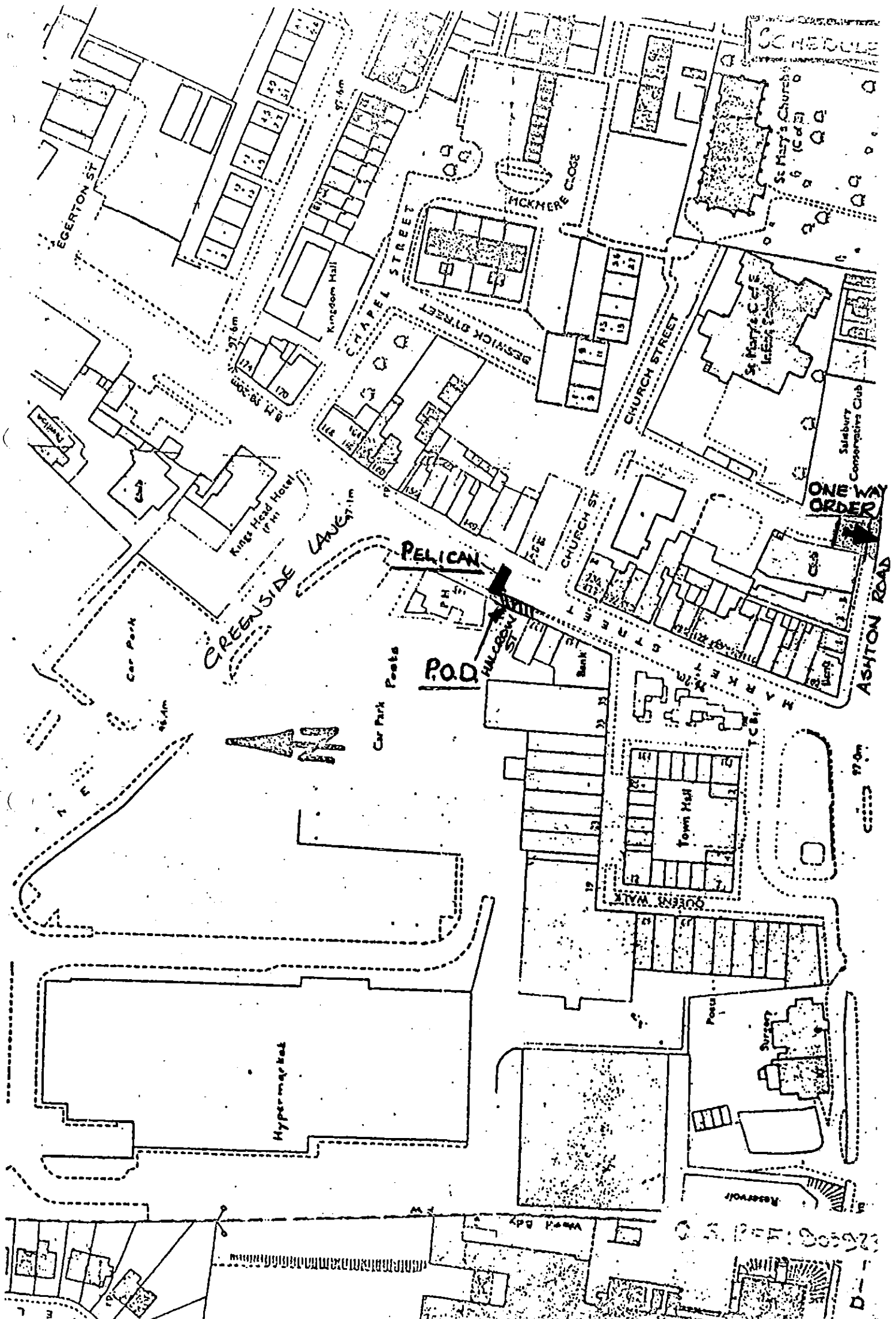
