

THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY
(FOOTPATHS OFF SUNNYSIDE ROAD AND CAMBRIDGE ROAD, DROYLSDEN)
(PROHIBITION OF CYCLING) ORDER 1976

THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as the "said County Council") in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1967") hereby make the following Order:-

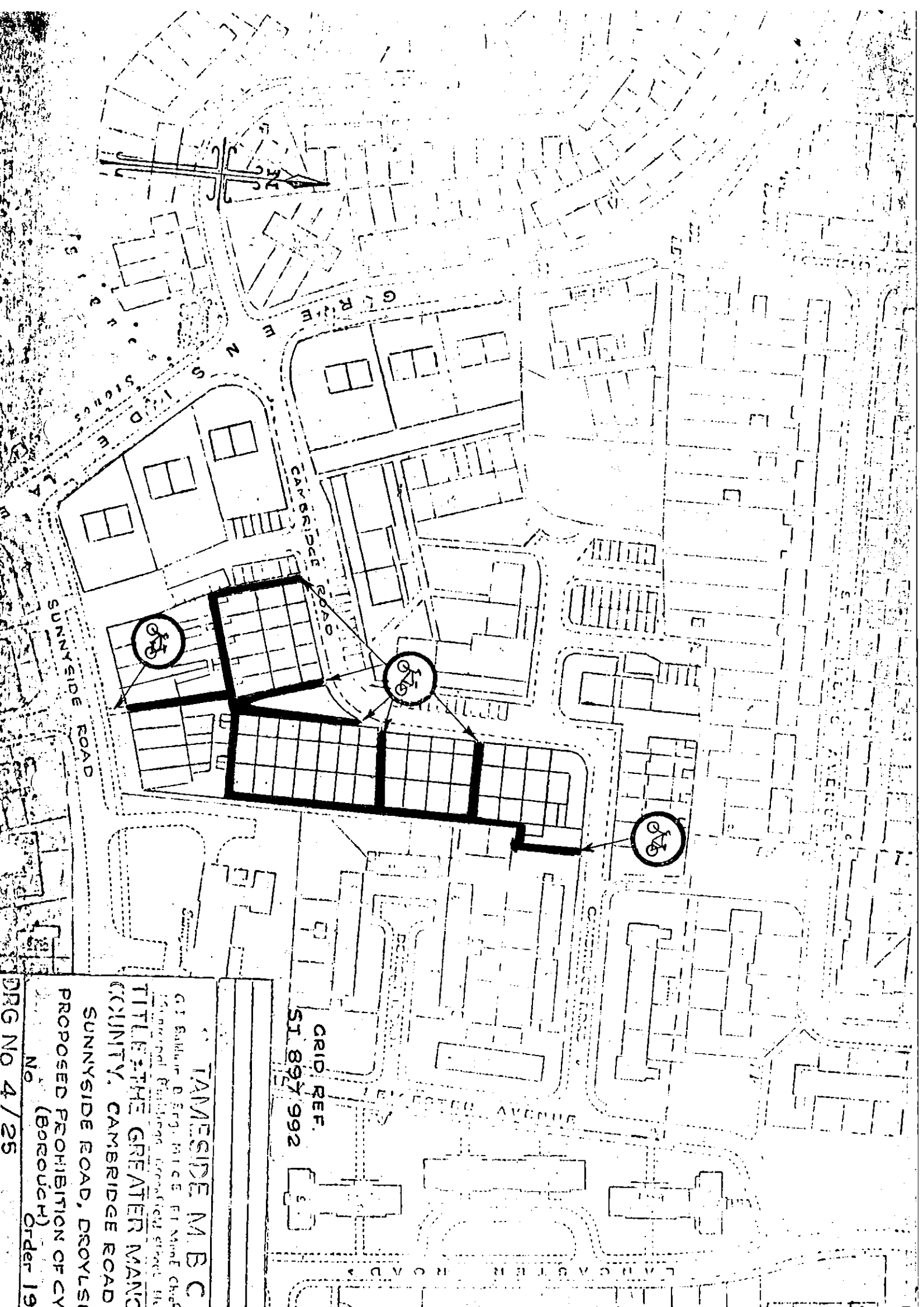
1. No person shall ride or cause to be ridden any pedal bicycle or tricycle on that length of footpath off Sunnyside Road, Droylsden, from a point 55 metres east of Greenside ^{lane} in a northerly direction; and the six footpaths on the south and east sides of Cambridge Road, Droylsden and connecting footpaths, as indicated on the plan.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Order shall come into operation on the *tenth* day of *January* 1977 and may be cited as "THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (FOOTPATHS OFF SUNNYSIDE ROAD AND CAMBRIDGE ROAD, DROYLSDEN) (PROHIBITION OF CYCLING) ORDER 1976.
