(HAMPSON STREET AND ALBION FOLD) DROYLSDEN

The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act"), having given notice in accordance with sub-Section (2) of that section and having consulted the Chief Officer of Policies in accordance with paragraph 20 of part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and with the consent of the Secretary of State in accordance with paragraph 13 of part II of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

(1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 mph on any of the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the 11th day of December 1995 and may be cited as the Tameside (20 mph Speed Limit Order) (Hampson Street and Albion Fold, Droylsden) Order 1995.

SCHEDULE

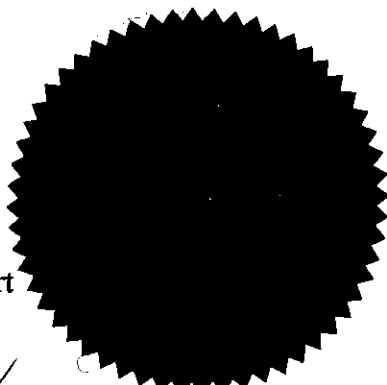
Hampson Street - from its junction with Medlock Street to its junction with Hart Street.

Albion Fold - from its junction with Hampson Street to its cul-de-sac ends.
